

Mentoring Group FAQ'S

How many people are in each group?

Including the leader and group members, it is suggested that there be no more than 3 to 4 people. Any more than this and people lose the ability to share what God is doing in their life.

Can we meet every other week?

No, we want to help each other take steps on a weekly basis. Although your group may need to miss a week here or there, mentoring groups are meant to meet every week.

How long is each session?

Each session will last between 1 and 1.5 hours.

Can we do coed groups?

No, mentoring groups are designed for us to open up and share everything God is doing in our lives. Men meet with men, and women meet with women.

How long does our mentoring group meet together as a group?

Your group will meet together for approximately one year. At that point, each member of the group is encouraged to branch out and lead their own group.

Will there be food/coffee?

If you want! Groups can meet for breakfast, lunch, coffee, or whatever works for your group.

Where can I find the material?

The material will be available electronically at pinnaclechurch.com/mentoring. You may print it out or access it from your device. If you need someone to print it for you, please let someone on the Pinnacle staff know.

Do I have to print in color?

No, black and white works great.

What do I, as a leader, need to provide for each session?

You'll need to provide the leader's guide for yourself, the explorer's guide for each member of your group, and a pen if you have printed materials.

Are these accountability groups?

No. These groups are based on invitation. A member is invited into the group and then challenged to grow as they share. However, the only thing people will be challenged on is what they invite the rest of the group to challenge them on.
